4. Robinson building mural



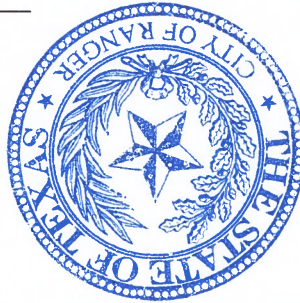
