

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01-21 A

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RANGER, TEXAS FILLING A VACANCY ON THE CITY COUNCIL BY APPOINTMENT TO SERVE UNTIL THE NEXT REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION, PROVIDING FINDINGS OF FACT; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, EFFECTIVE DATE, AND OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Ranger, Texas ("City) Charter, provides for the appointment of vacancies by resolution;

WHEREAS, James "Charlie" Archer, Commissioner Place 2, was duly appointed as Mayor of the City on December 24th, 2024, creating a vacancy on the Council;

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 3 of the City Charter provides if for any reason a vacancy exists on the governing body, the City Commission by resolution duly entered and adopted in a regular session may fill the vacancy by appointment; and

WHEREAS, the appointee named in Section 2 possesses all the qualifications for Commissioners contained in Section 4 of Article V of the City Charter;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANGER:

Section 1. Findings of Fact. All of the above premises and recitations are found to be true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Resolution as findings of fact, as if copied herein in their entirety.

Section 2. Appointment of Commissioner Place 1. The City Council appoints Vicky Doyle to fill the office of Commissioner Place 2 for the unexpired term and until the next regular municipal election pursuant to City Charter.

Section 3. Appointment of Commissioner Place 2. The City Council appoints Jim McClough to fill the office of Commissioner Place 2 for the unexpired term and until the next regular municipal election pursuant to City Charter.

Section 4. Appointment of Commissioner Place 3. The City Council appoints Robert Butler to fill the office of Commissioner Place 2 for the unexpired term and until the next regular municipal election pursuant to City Charter.


Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.

Section 6. Open Meetings. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapt. 551, Tex. Gov't. Code.
