

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-11-24-A

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF RANGER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE FOR THE MITIGATION COMMUNITIES PROGRAM PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000 FOR A THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Ranger seeks to promote orderly growth, improve public infrastructure, mitigate risk, and enhance the quality of life for its residents through the development of comprehensive and integrated long-range planning; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG), administered by the General Land Office, provides funding for eligible planning activities that support community and economic development that are supported through the development, adoption, and implementation of codes, ordinances, and land use decisions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ranger is eligible to apply for a CDBG Mitigation Communities Program Project grant to prepare a comprehensive plan that will guide future development, land use decisions, mitigate risks that consider flood and wildfire damage, infrastructure investments, and community priorities; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds it in the best interest of the City and its citizens to apply for and secure \$300,000 in CDBG funding for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF RANGER, TEXAS:

1. The City Commission hereby authorizes the submission of an application to the General Land Office for a CDBG Mitigation Communities Program Project Grant in the amount of \$300,000 to fund the development of a Comprehensive Plan.
2. The Mayor is designated as the City's Authorized Representative, with the authority to execute all application documents, certifications, agreements, and reports required by the General Land Office for the purpose of applying for, receiving, and administering the grant.
3. The City of Ranger affirms that it will comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, program rules, policies, and requirements associated with the Community Development Block Grant Program.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.
