A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF RANGER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT & REVITALIZATION 2016 HOUSING PROJECT APPLICATION TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT & REVITALIZATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Ranger desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of Ranger to apply for funding under the Community Development & Revitalization Grant Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED;

Section 1. That a Community Development & Revitalization Grant Program application is hereby authorized to be filed with the Texas General Land Office for funding consideration under the 2016 Community Development & Revitalization Grant Program; and

Section 2. That the application be for up to the maximum amount of grant funds of \$2 million to carry out non-housing activities; and


Section 3. That the City in its efforts to provide for improvements to areas of the City repetitively damaged by flooding commits a minimum 1% match of cash and/or in-kind services to the project

Section 4. That the City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the Chief Executive Officer's and Authorized Representative's to act in all matters in connection with this application and participation in the Community Development & Revitalization Grant Program.
