

Resolution No. 2018-09-24-Q

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANGER, TEXAS, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF TEXAS THROUGH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE STATE HIGHWAY 101 (MAIN ST.) FROM THE RANGER SWIMMING POOL TO COMMERCE STREET FOR THE RANGER INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT "HOMECOMING PARADE".

WHEREAS: the City Council of the City of Ranger in cooperation with the State of Texas for the safety and convenience of the traveling public; and

WHEREAS: the City of Ranger request the temporary closure of State Highway 101 (Main St.), & Commerce St., the intersection of State Highway 101 and FM 717(Austin St.) and the intersection of State Highway 101 and Pine Street on Friday, October 12, 2018, for parade activities associated with the Ranger Independent School District Homecoming Activities;
And

WHEREAS: the events located within the City of Ranger incorporated area and the closure will be performed within the State's requirements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF RANGER, TEXAS:

Section 1. That at the regular meeting of the City Council held on the 24th day of September, 2018 this resolution was adopted in accordance with Chapter 43 Texas Administrative Code, Section 22.12 and comply with the rules and procedures established by said Chapter and Section.

Section 2. This resolution is adopted so that the Ranger Independent School District may conduct the "Homecoming Parade" on Friday, October 12, 2018.


